



After providing depreciation of Rs. 148.38 Lakhs and earmarking of Rs. 305.09 Lakhs for various earmarked funds, the foundation recorded a surplus of Rs. 148.27 Lakhs.



RVG Scholarship Fund and RVG Financial Assistance Fund

We at RVG strongly believe in offering the best services, support and motivation to our students. RVG offers Merit Scholarship to appreciate the efforts of the rank holders who secure admission at RVG and also offers assistance to financially support the students coming from a humble background and securing admission at RVG.

To support the above-mentioned cause, RVG had created a fund in the name of RVG Scholarship Fund and donations received from donors to support the students is transferred to this fund on regular basis.

In order to expand our reach and support to more students, a new scheme was devised in the year 2021-2022 wherein donors, who would be willing to be part of this noble cause of contribution towards RVG Financial Assistance Fund can help us support one student for a period of 3 years, 6 years or 9 years and the details of the contribution is as follows:

RVG offers a financial assistance of Rs. 4,000 per month to a male student and Rs. 5,500 per month to a female student.

Needless to mention, we have strict checks and process to verify and shortlist the beneficiaries. Donations so made are eligible for U/S 80 G of the Income Tax Act, 1961 and under CSR depending upon your preference.



RVG Girls Hostel at JB Nagar, Mumbai

RVG Educational Foundation has been one of the most coveted hostel service providers for aspiring CA students and the admission process in March 2022 was no different than the earlier ones which made us think about the dire need to arrange for additional accommodation / hostel facility for outstation female students coming to Mumbai for



pursuing a course in Chartered Accountancy. As always, we received an overwhelming response for new admissions at girls hostel, but our existing facility was already an at 100% capacity.

With the best efforts put in by the members of RVG and Panchayati Seva Trust, Satyanarayan Goenka Bhawan at JB Nagar, Andheri East was identified as an ideal location to begin a new hostel facility. The girls hostel at JB Nagar became operational in May 2022 and now offers hostel accomodation and services to 24 female students.

RVG Educational Foundation whole heartedly thank the office bearers of Panchayati Seva Trust for offering their support to this noble cause.

Expansion project of Agrawal Oswal Chhatrawas



The expansion project of Agrawal Oswal Chhatrawas is progressing well and we are aiming to make it operational soon.

This facility will add more strength to the objects of RVG by offering another 240 seats to the existing capacity of 500 male students.

A full floor dedicated to diverse activities will be the centre of attraction and a happening place. We also plan to convert the rooms under construction and the existing rooms into

airconditioned rooms to add to the comfort of the students residing at our hostel. With the completion of this project, RVG will be able to offer its services to about 750 male students under one roof.

Proposed Hostel project at Kandivali, Mumbai



In order to extend our support to many more aspiring Chartered Accountants, RVG has planned a new hostel facility at Kandivali, Mumbai.

We are in the process of completing the formalities for acquiring land and are expecting approvals from the respective authorities. We expect the project to flag off in this calendar year and once completed this facility will be open to students resulting in accommodation to about 1000 additional students.

We plan to construct three hostels on this plot, namely one for female students (approx. 400 capacity) and two for male students (approx. 600 capacity in total).

With the completion of this project, we would not be wrong in saying that RVG Educational Foundation will be a one of its kind service provider in India, for facilitating Chartered Accountancy students.

Skill Development

a. Personality Development and Communication Skill Development Course (PCSDC)

In tune to our vision to ensure holistic development of each and every student, we organize PCSDC sessions for our students. This course is conducted by industry experts and it is mandatory for students to be a part of these sessions. This course emphasizes on the grooming and soft skill aspect of every student. Spirituality, Public Speaking, Confidence Building, Content Development, Corporate Etiquettes, Time Management are some of the modules covered under this course.

The most common feedback from students on this course is "To be honest, I wasn't that excited about the PCSDC batch at first but then I had a lot of fun and I am glad I didn't miss it. It was absolutely worth attending the class every day."

b. Academic & Non Academic Events

Guest Talks, Coffee sessions with Alumni, Webinars, Sessions by BCAS, Annual Day, Annual Fest, Celebration of festivals, Sports and a series of similar events are organized round the year, not only for physical and mental development of the students but also to ensure that every student enjoys hostel life and does not miss out on college life.

RVG Merit Scholarship Scheme

This scheme is for motivating our students and also to recognize the efforts & achievements of our students securing all India rank in IPCC examinations conducted by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. Under this scheme a scholarship of Rs.2000/- per month is provided to every student who has secured all India rank in IPCC examination. During the year 32 students benefitted under this scheme.





RVG Financial Assistance Scheme

This scheme is for students from humble backgrounds. Under this scheme financial assistance of Rs. 4000/- per month to a male student and Rs. 5500/- per month to a female student is being provided. During the year 51 students benefitted under this scheme.

Healthy Mind and a Healthy Body

Food Service: Pure vegetarian, hygienic & nutritious food is served to all students at very subsidized rates.

The members of the Mess committee ensure that a variety of quality food is being served to all the students. The mess is active almost 24×7 during exams to help students by serving tea / coffee and snacks.

Health Insurance: Apart from serving healthy food, all the students of this Institution are covered under the group medical insurance scheme that provides a medical cover of Rs. 3 Lakhs to each student at a very nominal cost.

Housekeeping: A professional agency ensures a completely clean and hygienic environment. All rooms and common areas are thoroughly cleaned and disinfected on regular basis. Health of all housekeeping staff is also monitored on daily basis.

Laundry Service : Laundry service at nominal cost is also made available to students.

Other Activities

Counselling & Mentoring : The House Chancellor, Alumni members and the Committee members ensure regular student interactions. They play a vital role in counselling and mentoring of the students by conducting Assembly sessions and Open House at regular intervals.

Indoor and Outdoor Sports : The hostel has well equipped indoor sports room facilitating playing of games like Chess, Carrom and Table Tennis. Students also have access to activity zone for physical exercise, yoga and similar activities.

The hostel also has a badminton court and open space to enjoy sports like kabbadi, kho kho, etc.

Reading Room : A well equipped, air conditioned, day and night reading room is the most used facility by the students. There are separate reading rooms designated for students having their exam attempts during different times of the year.






- a. Airconditioned and regular reading room

- We have installed LED lights across the campus to ensure less power consumption.
- We strictly follow the waste segregation process and have made all arrangements to dispose the Dry & Wet garbage. We have installed a Bio Compost Plant to decompose the Dry & Wet Waste resulting in generation of organic manure that can be used to fertilize the beautiful mini garden on our premises.

Expansion Projects



Agrawal Oswal Chhatrawas

One of the institutions of RVG is the Agrawal Oswal Chhatrawas ('AOC').

It accommodates 210 male students as on date. This building comprises of basement, ground floor & upper 5 floors, being used for educational & hostel purposes.

A large number of out station students are placed at Mumbai for their articleship and face a serious challenge in finding a hostel with adequate facilities. Therefore, to cater to the need of the students and help them with the best of the facilities, RVG has taken up the project for expansion of the above-mentioned building.

We have added Seven (7) more upper floors to the existing building & the expected cost of construction is approximately Rs. 36 Crores (Rupees Thirty Six Crores).

Twelfth (12th) floor, is a non-residential floor dedicated for leisure, indoor sports, overall development and training activities for the students.

This expansion project has created additional facility for 240 students and AOC in total would be able to serve 450 students. The facility will be put to use from October 2022 Term.



RVG Girls Hostel at JB Nagar, Mumbai

RVG Educational Foundation has been one of the most coveted hostel service providers for the aspiring CA students and the admission process for the year 2022-2023 was no different than the earlier ones which made us think on the dire need to arrange for additional accommodation / hostel facility for outstation female students coming to Mumbai for pursuing a course in Chartered Accountancy.

With the best efforts put in by the members of RVG and Panchayati Seva Trust, Satyanarayan Goenka Bhawan at JB Nagar, Andheri East was identified as an ideal location to start hostel facility. This hostel became operational on 10th May 2022, and now offers services to 24 female students.

Each room at this hostel is air-conditioned and offers a comfortable three bed facility with attached washrooms. As it is rightly said, quality comes at a price, the operational costs at this hostel is steep but as a matter of fact, RVG has always endeavoured to offer the best facilities at the least possible cost to the students, the management decided to offer the facility at a subsidized rate resulting in offering the facility to students at a price far less than the operational cost.

At present RVG has FOUR hostels at Mumbai,

- 2. Agrawal Oswal Chhatrawas (Boys hostel at Andheri West)
- 3. Vijay Shrigopal Khetan Girls Hostel (Goregaon East)
- 4. RVG Girls Hostel (JB Nagar, Andheri East)

thus, providing accommodation to 550 plus male and 150 plus female students

Despite having four hostels, we always felt the pain of not able to offer seats to all the applicants looking forward to secure admission at RVG.

We plan to construct three hostels on this plot, namely one for female students (approx. 400 capacity) and two for male students (approx. 600 capacity in total).

- (i) Tenders were invited for repairs or construction involving expenditure exceeding Rs.5000/-.
- (j) No money of the trust has been invested contrary to the provisions of Section 35 of the Act.
- (k) That there were no alienations in immoveable property contrary to the provision of Section 36.
- (I) That there were no cases of irregular, illegal or improper expenditure or failure or omission to recover money or any other property belonging to the trust or of loss or waste of money or any property thereof.
- (m) That budget has been filed in the form prescribed by rule 16 A.
- (n) Having regard to the provisions of the Instrument of the trust -
 - (o) The maximum and minimum number of trustees have been maintained.
 - (p) Meetings have been regularly held.
 - (q) Minute book of the proceedings of the meeting has been maintained.
 - (r) No trustee has any interest in the investment of the trust.
 - (s) No trustee is a debtor or creditor of the trust.
- (t) No irregularities were reported in the accounts of the previous year. Hence the question of compliance by the trustees does not arise.
- (u) That there is no other special matter which is considered fit or necessary to be brought to the notice of the Assistant Charity Commissioner.

Note "1" Significant Accounting Policies

1. Organisation Overview

RVG Educational Foundation ('the Society/ trust or RVGEF') is registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 as well as Maharashtra Public Trust Act, 1950 as a democratic body with Non-profit motives. RVGEF is also a registered Public Charitable Trust. It has been granted registration No. BOM 67 of 1960 (GBBSD) on 16/08/1960 under the Societies Registration Act, 1860. It has also been granted registration No.F-844(Bombay) on 07/02/1961 by the Charity Commissioner, Mumbai under the provisions of the Maharashtra Public Trusts Act, 1950.

Principle activity of the Trust is to provide a complete educational eco-system to the students pursuing higher education in Mumbai. This Institution through its institutional facilities in Mumbai is helping the youth pursuing the course of Chartered Accountancy at Mumbai to become a Chartered Accountant.

2. Significant Accounting Policies

2.1 Basis of preparation of Financial Statements

The balance sheet and income and expenditure accounts are prepared under the historical cost convention and on the accrual basis of accounting. These statements have been prepared in accordance with the significant accounting policies as described below.

2.2 Use of Estimates

The preparation of the financial statements requires that the Trustees of the Trust ('Trustee') make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of income and expenditure of the year and reported balance of assets and liabilities. Management believes that the estimates used in the preparation of financial statements are prudent and reasonable. Actual results could differ from those estimates. Any revision to accounting estimates is recognized prospectively in current and future periods. All amounts are stated in Indian rupees.

2.3 Fixed Assets and Depreciation

Fixed Assets are capitalized at cost of acquisition. Cost includes cost incurred to bring the assets to their present location and condition.

Depreciation on fixed assets has been provided for on straight line value method (SLM) at the rates considering the balance useful life of the assets worked out and minuted by Executive Committee.

From Financial Year 2014-15, depreciation is being provided on Straight Line Method (SLM). Opening Balance under Gross Block is aggregate amount of Opening Written down Value (WDV) as at 01/04/2014 and additions made at cost thereafter.

Land is not depreciated. Depreciation is charged at half the normal rate in case of assets put to use for less than 180 days during the year.



Intangible Assets are capitalized at cost of development / acquisition. Intangible Assets are amortized on straight line value method at the rates considering the balance useful life worked out and minuted by Executive Committee.

2.4 Investments

Investments are stated at cost.

2.5 Revenue Recognition

Term Fees from students has been accounted as income on accrual basis.

Donation received in cash or in kind is recognized as income when the donation is received.

Donations made with a specific direction that they shall form part of the corpus fund of the Trust are classified as corpus donations, and are directly reflected as trust fund receipts in the balance sheet.

Income from service charges for use of trust properties for various events is recognized on time proportion basis.

2.6 Other Income

Interest on deployment of funds is recognized using the time-proportion method, based on underlying interest rates.

Interest on Income on Income tax refund is recognized in the year of receipt.

2.7 Employee Benefits

Employee benefits payable wholly within twelve months of rendering the services are classified as short term employee benefits and are recognized in the period in which the employee renders the related service. Trust has taken Group Gratuity Scheme from Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC). Contribution paid to LIC is accounted as expenditure in year of payment.

2.8 Resources Expensed

All expenditure are accounted on accrual basis of accounting and has been classified under the heading that aggregates all costs relating to that category.

2.9 Taxes on Income

No provision for Income tax has been made as the Institution is registered under Section 12A of the Income Tax Act, 1961 ('the Act'). Under the provisions of the Act, the income of the Trust is exempted from tax, subject to the compliance of terms and conditions specified in the Act.

2.10 Provision and Contingent Liabilities

Provisions are recognized when there is a present obligation as a result of past event and it is probable that an outflow of resources will be required to settle the obligation, in respect



of which a reliable estimate can be made. These are reviewed at each Balance Sheet date and adjusted to reflect the current best estimates.

A disclosure for a contingent liability is made when there is a possible or present obligation that may, but probably will not require an outflow of resources. When there is a possible obligation in respect of which the likelihood of outflow of resources is remote, no provision or disclosure is made.

Accounting policies not specifically referred to otherwise are consistent with the generally accepted accounting practices.

2.11 Accounting of Subsidy Receipts

Subsidy received is accounted for on cash basis and considered as Income in the year of receipt of subsidy.

3. Contingent Liability

There is no contingent liability at the end of the year except Income tax demand raised of Rs. 74,94,414/- in respect of Assessment Year 2017-18. Necessary application for rectification and appeal with CIT(A) are filed and same are pending for disposal. Management is confident that on disposal of our appeal demands would be quashed as same are not based on facts.

- 4. Deposits under schedule "5" of current assets includes a sum of Rs. 15,00,000/- paid to vendor of Goregaon hostel property on execution of conveyance in favour of trust (RVG). Refund of this amount by vendor is contingent to completion of his income tax assessments involving no income tax demands on him on account of executing conveyance in favor of RVG.
- 5. The Trust has negotiated a transaction of acquisition of piece of land in Kandivali West for the purpose of furthering its objectives. Advances paid and expense incurred in this connection are shown as ' Advances against WIP'. The process of title clearance and completion of legal formalities are in progress.
- 6. Donation for AOC Building Extension for the current year appearing in Income and Expenditure Account at Rs. 2,54,84,136/- is net off of the amount of donation refunded during the the year.

7. Previous Year Figures

Previous Year figures are Re-grouped and Re-arranged wherever necessary to confirm the current year's Figures.




RVG Alumni
