1. I am doing B. Com, B. A., B. Sc., MBA, Engineering, C.S., ICWA or any other course. Whether I am eligible for admission in the hostel?

2. What are the criteria / eligibility for New Admission / Renewal of Admission in the Hostel for Students?  
A. a) Students pursuing Chartered Accountancy Course & pursuing Articleship in Mumbai Region;  
b) Students who have completed minimum age of 18 years and are less than 25 years of age as on the commencement of the Term;  
c) Student should have passed IPC Examination (Both groups);  
d) New Student who has applied for registration as an Articled Student is also eligible (should submit supporting documents within One month from the commencement of the term else admission, if granted will be cancelled).
  
3. Whether students who are appearing for CPT exam or passed CPT Exam are eligible for admission?

4. Whether Students who have passed one group of IPC exam & are registered as Article Clerk are eligible for admission?

8. Whether I have to undergo Induction Program after admission as a New Student?
- A. Yes, it is mandatory for all New Students to attend. It is mostly conducted on Sunday of April & October for the respective term.
9. Is it mandatory for me to undergo Program conducted by the Institution in the first term of my New Admission?
- A. Yes. You have to complete RVG's Personality & Communication Skill Development Course (PCSDC) during this term. If you do not complete the PCSDC course before expiry of the said term, Rs.1000/- paid by you will be forfeited and you may not be eligible for renewal of the admission in the next term.

11. For renewal of admission, do I have to undergo any evaluation process?
- A. Yes. Renewal for next term is not by default. Renewal depends on your performance, behavior and participation in the various programs. You are required to submit self declaration alongwith renewal form & other supporting and appear for an interview with the House Chancellor within the specified dates.

12. What are the important dates for admission on “Exam Basis”?
- A. Grant of admission is subject to fulfillment of the criterias and availability of Seats. Tentative dates are given.

13. My term will be over on the last day of March/September. I wish to appear for CA Final Exams from Mumbai. Is it possible for me to stay till last day of final exams?
- A. Student should submit an application requesting this Institute to allow extension of stay at the Hostel beyond the expiry of the term till the final exams are over on “Extension Basis”. Student may be allowed to stay at the hostel subject to availability of seats and has to pay additional fees as per the details provided in the Fee Structure.
14. What are the fees & other charges payable to this Institution for seeking admission (New/Renewal/Exam Basis/Extension Basis)?

15. Whether above fee includes mess charges?
- A. No.
16. What sort of mess facilities available in the hostel & what are the charges for these facilities?
- A. All payments related to the mess facilities shall be made by student to Mess Contactor directly either on daily and/or monthly basis. Menu for food is suggested by the Student’s Mess Committee. Following facilities are provided in the Mess:
- Morning Breakfast
  - Lunch
  - Evening Snacks
  - Dinner
  - Tea & Juice
17. Whether I can stay in the hostel after completion of article-ship?
- A.** No. You have to vacate within three days from the completion of articleship. Further, fees paid for the remaining term will not be refunded under any circumstances. Stay beyond grace period of three days from the date of completion of the articleship shall attract penalty of Rs.500/- per day till the date of surrender (**subject to availability of rooms and prior permission of the Superintendent / Warden**)
18. Whether I have to appear personally for interview?
- A. Yes on the date as mentioned in the Notice.

19. What procedure is to be followed after new admission in the hostel?
- A. Selected Students shall appear for an interview before the House Chancellor between 10.30 am to 2.00 pm on the date mentioned in the admission notice. Thereafter, the student has to submit the fees by way of Payorder / Demand Draft / Banker's Cheque drawn in favour of Rajasthan Vidyarthi Griha payable at Mumbai at the Office alongwith its photocopy. Payments by Cash/ Self drawn cheques/ RTGS/NEFT strictly not allowed.
20. Whether student's local guardian have to accompany him after admission in the hostel & when?
- A. Student's local guardian has to accompany him/her to sign the undertaking in the office of the respective hostel between 10.30 am to 2.00 pm. (except Sunday) during the period mentioned in the admission notice.
21. What if the prescribe fees is not paid on time mentioned in admission notice?
- A. If prescribed fee is not paid by the due date, admission of such student is liable to be cancelled.
22. Does RVG provide any Scholarship to the student from humble background?
- A. Yes, RVGians are eligible for "RVG Financial Assistance Scholarship" where in Scholarship of Rs.2500/- p.m. to the boys and Rs.4000/- p.m. to girls is granted. Eligible students can avail this facility.
23. Does Rajasthan Vidyarthi Griha provide any Merit Scholarship to the deserving students?
- B. Yes, to the RVGians who are rank holders at IPC exams. RVG has a scholarship scheme namely; "RVG Merit Scholarship Scheme" where in Scholarship of Rs.1000/- p.m. is granted. Eligible students can avail this facility.
